New Artifacts are on Display in the *Charlotte Stories: Our Collections, Your Treasures* Exhibit

For the past year, the Charlotte Museum of History's exhibit, *Charlotte Stories: Our Collections, Your Treasures* has been a hit for visitors. Based upon the museum's mission to collect, preserve, research, and interpret regional artifacts, the exhibit explores items that help to tell stories from Charlotte's history. The "Our Collections" portion highlights items in the museum collection seldom seen on display, while "Your Treasures" features unique items loaned to us by members of the community.

The exhibit contains a wide variety of items covering an impressive scope. The artifacts on display are consistently rotated to keep the exhibit updates, as well as for conservation purposes.

Visit the museum this summer to see the latest additions to the exhibit which include an Isaac Price sword. Made between 1790 and 1815 by Steele Creek sword and gun manufacturer Isaac Price, the sword was a recent donation from the Steele Creek community of Mecklenburg County. Its story, and many others, can be found in *Charlotte Stories: Our Collections, Your Treasures*.
